

Attended University of Alabama for a year before entering the US Navy during WW II in 1943 - served until 1946. John Participated in the invasion of Sicily, Salerno, Anzio and Normandy. His ship was hit by mines in '44. On the way home after repairs, the ship was torpedoed and sank in December '44. John received commendation for saving the lives of some of his fellow crewmen.

He returned to Alabama in '46 where he received three Varsity letters in Baseball. Signed with the Brooklyn Dodgers, and while he participated in Football workouts, he could not participate in games because he had signed a pro baseball contract. He graduated from Alabama in 1949 with a BS Degree.
